### **Anti-Bullying Week 2023 Monday 13<sup>th</sup>- Friday 17<sup>th</sup> November**

This year the theme for Anti Bullying week is **'Make a Noise about Bullying': To empower children to do something positive to counter the harm and hurt caused by bullying.** It is coordinated by the Anti-Bullying Alliance which aims to support schools and other settings to help children and young people, school staff, parents and other professionals who work with children to understand:

- The definition of respect
- That bullying is a behaviour choice
- That we can respectfully disagree with each other i.e. we don't have to be best friends or always agree with each other but we do have to respect each other
- That we all need to choose to respect each other, both face to face and online

***"Too often, we are silent when we see bullying take place, silent about the hurt bullying causes, and silent when we hear bullying dismissed as 'just banter'. It doesn't have to be this way.***
