
Year 4

Dear Parents.

Welcome to the Autumn Term of Year 4. We are so pleased to see the children back in school after their summer holiday. We hope that our flyer will be useful as your child settles back into school life and we look forward to an excellent autumn term ahead.

If you have any queries, please do not hesitate to chat with us after school.

Reading

As your child moves into Year Four, it is important to encourage them to read as often as possible, both with an adult but also independently. We would strongly recommend that you hear your child read their school reading books at least three times a week. We will continue to read with them at school and keep their Learning Logs up to date. Although your child may be confident to read their books, you should continue to support them at home by assisting them with the comprehension of the text, through the discussion of what they have read.

Maths

It would be of great benefit if you could continue to help your child to **learn their times tables up to 12 x 12**, number bonds and practice calculations on apps such as Times Table Rock Stars (your child has been given their login). These form the foundations to all of our number work.

Home Learning

Your child will receive a set of ten spellings on a weekly basis. These spellings will then be tested every Friday. In addition to this, both basic skills and creative learning tasks will be set on an alternate basis: handed out on a Friday and due in the following Thursday (2 weeks for a creative task). We hope that this will accommodate families that either prefer to support with home learning at the weekend or on week nights.
