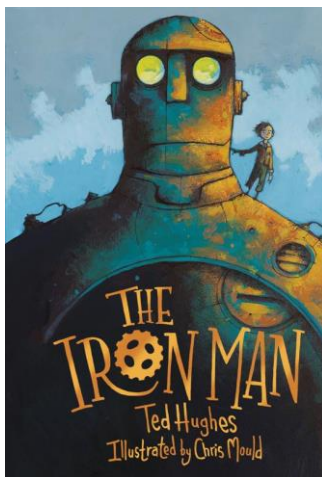


## Geography
