Know and remember key dates of the period studied.

Identify how centuries link to numbered years.

Political and international tensions leading up to WWII. Evaluate causes

for the outbreak of war (cause and consequence)

Economic impact of WWII – rationing

Identify how aspects of life have changed during a period and give reasons why. Evacuation, rationing, women's role...

Analyse a range of sources independently – evacuation graph, photos of evacuated children, life at home "What impact did WWII have on life on the home front?"

The Blitz (enguiry question and significance)

Geography

Label Allies and Axis of Power, countries involved in the conflict of WWII, on a World map.

Name and locate cities and counties of the UK – Evacuation and Reception areas.

Use six figure grid references – grid ref. of bombs dropped in local area.

Soldier Art – draw portraits with correct proportion and portray emotions through facial expressions. Poppy Art – watercolour landscapes and pastel poppies on strips of cartridge paper.
