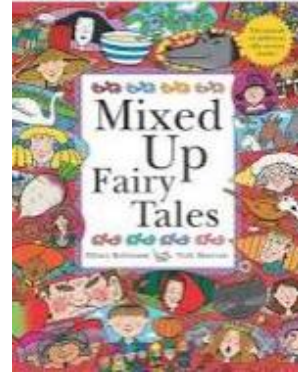
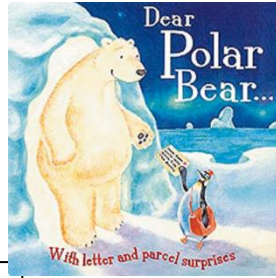


Communication Language and Literacy

Use Google Earth- Where do we live?

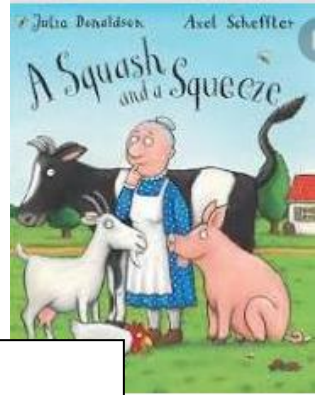

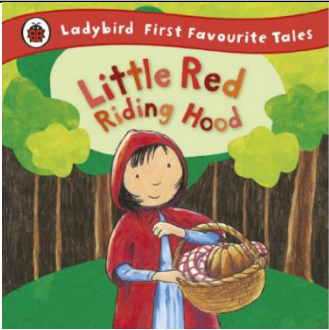
